RULES

1. The name of the draw is the 200 Club ("the Club") regardless of the number of shares.
2. The Club is intended to be a private lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005. The Club shall be registered as a lottery with Harborough District Council.
3. The Club will be run by the PTA Committee, who are registered with Harborough District Council as the Promoter for the Club
4. The sole objective is to raise money to support John Wycliffe Primary School through PTA funds as set out in the PTA Constitution.
5. The initial target will be 200 shares to be held by members of the club, although there will be no upper limit on shares issued. Members can hold up to 5 shares each.
6. Each share will have a unique number. No physical shares will be issued. Members can request their share number(s) by contacting the Promoter.
7. Shares will be sold at £2 per month for a minimum contract period of 12 months payable by Standing Order. Thereafter, 3 months written notice will be required to withdraw from membership in the Club. Money paid for shares will not be refundable under any circumstances.
8. The minimum stake shall be £2 per month (1 share) and up to a maximum of £10 per month (5 shares). Consequently payments by standing order will be for £2, £4, £6, £8, or £10 per month.
9. Anyone over the age of 18 may join.
10. Prizes will be distributed following a monthly draw. Prize draws will take place in the last week of the month and the first monthly draw will take place in January 2011.
11. All participants are entitled to attend the draws, which must be held in the presence of at least 3 members of the PTA Committee.
12. 40% of the income will be paid as prizes. The following example illustrates the distribution of prizes based on 200 members paying £2 per month:
1st prize £85 2nd prize £50 3rd prize £25
13. The value of prizes will be pro-rata according to the level of subscriptions if 200 shares are not sold.
14. Winners will be paid by cheque. Only those shares paid for will be valid for receipt of prizes. Prizes will only be paid to the purchaser of a winning share.
15. A list of winners will be displayed on the PTA notice board in the school grounds.
16. A register will be kept of members, prizes paid out and funds raised. This will be audited each year as part of the PTA accounts.
17. The Club's bank account shall be the PTA account based with NatWest Bank
18. All running expenses shall be taken from the profit and not the prize money.
19. Any decision by the PTA to end the lottery will be by one month's notice to all participants.
20. An appeal may be made to the PTA Committee whose decision shall be final.

22. The PTA may amend or vary the Rules of the lottery at any time. Changes will be notified via the PTA section of the School website.
23. Any matters not covered by these Rules will be decided by the PTA Committee.
